

Roscoe Warren Home, 1685 Dover Road, Epsom, NH

This property was originally part of the William Goss owned land which was bought of the Daniel Cilley Estate. Lizzie Warren, wife of George E. Warren bought the property in 1883 from William and Rebecca Goss, and there is no mentiion of buildings at the time. The 1892 map shows the house and the G.M. Warren Store, which was sold and removed by 1895, and housed for a short time the books of the Epsom Library. The house remains in the hands of descendants as of 2006.

CHRONOLOGY of owners (not necessarily resident):

1883, Mrs. Lizzie M. Warren of Epsom from William and Rebecca Goss of Epsom, 1 acre more or less commencing at a stone standing in the ground near the water course at the northeast corner of said tract by the said turnpike road, thence running southerly and easterly by the Shoe Factory Mill Pond or high water mark to land of Horace Bickford, thence northerly by said Horace Bickfords land to said turnpike road, thence westerly by said road to bound first mentioned; 1909, George E. Warren from Lizzie M. Warren, all my real estate in Epsom with buildings thereon; 1934, Clara E. Warren from George E. Warren from Clara E. Russell, widow of Epsom; 1959, Gertrude E. Warren from Roscoe E. Warren; 1989, transfer of real estate to Cindy L. Warren, administrator, estate of Gertrude F. Warren, late of Epsom.

GENEALOGY: George Edwin Warren was the son of George Meader Warren and his wife Sarah Esther Fellows. George E. married Mary 'Lizzie' Elizabeth Holmes, and they had for children: Isabel Sophia who married Horace Marden; Minnie Eunice; Elsie Norine who married William Henry Knowles; Edna E.; George Edwin and Joseph Albert who married Lucy Heacock. George Edwin married first Clara E. Brown, daughter of Charles J. Brown and Leonora Jones of Gilmanton. George and Clara had for children: Marie Eunice, Arlin Brown, Roscoe George and Vernon Clyde. Geogre E. married second Mary E. Goodwin and had a child Norine Edna.
