

Schricker Home, 90 Lord's Mill Road, Epsom, NH

There is no indication of a house on this lot early on, but does appear on the 1858 County Map. At that time it is labeled as A. and C.E. Prescott, which would be Charles E. and his father Asa. It would appear that this is the homestead of Asa Prescott and family sometime after 1811. The land was in the vicinity of McClary's mill and land owners probably took advantage of the timber located on the lot. The Osgood family in Epsom early on and many of the sons and daughters married and raised families in the town. The house is on the old turnpike road to Northwood, NH.

CHRONOLOGY of owners (not necessarily resident):

1781, Thomas Berry of Greenland from Thomas Berry Jr. of Greenland, 100 acres, 1/2 of both lots 24 & 25 in the first range, east end owned by William Berry, deceased, the Berry family obtaining it from the original owners; 1789, Samuel Osgood of Epsom from Thomas Berry of Greenland, 40 acres on the easterly side of the Northwood (Lord's Mill) Road; 1806, Samuel and Isaac Osgood from James Harvey McClary, land in lot 26 & 27; January 1811, Isaac Osgood from Samuel and Abigail Osgood part of lot 24 & 25 and other land purchased from J.H. McClary; November 1811, Stephen Johnson form Isaac Osgood, part of lot 24 & 25 in the 1st range and also 1/4 of McClary's mill; Before 1858, Charles Prescott obtains property from Stephen Johnson; 1874, Ellery C. Kelley from Charles E. Prescott; about 1878 Fannie and George Bodwell by marriage and will; 1884, Benjamin M. and Emma Chase from Fannie, wife of George Bodwell; 1891, Jeremiah Witham from Benjamin F. Chase with buildings thereon, 75 acres; by deed the property passed to Irving M. Locke from Bertha P. Yeaton, 2nd wife of George D. Yeaton; 1930, Gertrude R. Foster via Will of Irving Locke (Linna M, Clarence B., Eva Locke Stevenson, Lillian Locke and Douglas Stevenson); 1948, Frank W. Chamberlain Jr from Gertrude R. Foster; 1950, Lewis and Catherine Loring from Frank W. Chamberlain Jr.; 1954, G. Phlip Trumbour et al from Lewis W. Loring and Catherine, 5 acres; June 1968, Dean M. Thomas et al from G. Philip Trumbour; 1968 Bank release Almon M. Lord; 1972, Andrew and Marion Schricker from Almon M Lord et al.

GENEALOGY: Samuel Osgood married Eleanor Morrill in 1763 and had children: Eleanor, Abraham, Lydia died young, Polly, Samuel died young, Samuel, Isaac, Lydia, Anna and Sarah. Son Isaac married Betsey Ham.

Charles E. Prescott was the son of Asa and Sophronia Bunker Prescott. Charles married Caroline F. Preston and had children: Mary E., Elizabeth, Charles Sewell and Martha E..

Ellery C. Kelley married Frances Tuvts and had children: Etta M. and Harry Scott. Upon Ellery's death she married George Bodwell.
