He could have been the son of JOHN TOWYLL named in the 1524 Subsidy Roll for the adjoining parish of Newton St. Cyres, or the ROBERT TOLY named in the same 1524 Subsidy Roll at Down St. Mary parish. Roger used both names for his sons. On 19 May 1566 he married at Colebrooke JOAN TAYLOR. No burial record for either parent was found.

Some twenty years later we find a PHILLIPE TOOLE marrying ARMINELL COMMONS on 31 Aug. 1663 at Crediton. He is named in the 1674 Devon Hearth Rolls, under "the poore of Crediton." He had one chimney. While we can't rule him out that he is the same Philip Towle, I believe he was a younger man. There is also the question of whether or not TOOLE equals TOWELL/TOWLE.

Hampton, N.H. he may be the 15. PHILIP TOWLE. PHILIP TOWLE found in 1641 at Crediton, Co. Devon. He was born about 1616. Just when he emigrated is not known with certainty. is not found at Hampton in any early records. Philip was buried 20 land owner Dec. 1696 at Hampton. His will is dated 18 Dec. 1696 and was proved 25 May 1697 at New Castle, N.H. he was at Hampton by 19 Nov. 1657 when he married ISABELLA AUSTIN, daughter of FRANCIS and ISABEL. (BLAND) AUSTIN. She was born about 1633 at Colchester, died at Hampton, England and 7 Dec. 1719. She was arrested suspicion of witchcraft, at a trial held at Hampton on 7 Sep. 1680 and jailed. She was released the following year after ISAAC JOHN REDMAN posted her bail. MARSTON and [see Appendix]

He signed the Oath of Allegiance 25 April 1678 and was freed from training 23 June 1681.

Note: During World War 2 the city of Exeter was bombed by the Germans. All the probate records were destroyed regretfully. The Index of Wills survives as do several will abstract books found at the West Country Library, Exeter, England.

ROGER TOWLE BOSTON, MASS.

ROGER TOWLE, Boston. While no evidence has been found, he could have been related to PHILIP TOWLE of Hampton, N.H. The name of ROGER was a name used by the TOWLEs of the parish of Crediton, Co. Devon. Roger was convicted 1 Dec. 1640 at the Quarter Court held at Boston for selling 2 lbs. of gunpower to the Indians. He was called "Mr. Henry Webb's man." He was probably an apprentice to Mr. Webb. Roger was admitted to the First Church of Boston on 23 Apr. 1644 and was named on the list of freeman under the first charter of the Mass. Colony 29 May 1644. What became of Roger Towle is unknown. Later in Boston records we find a Richard Towle paying a tax of 24p in 1674 and a Richard Towle Jr. taxed in 1688. Their relationship to Roger Towle is unknown.

Perhaps the Roger Towell, willing to go to St. Christopher 20 Feb. 1639, is the same man. He is listed as a suspected pick pocket and haunter of the Custom House. [Bridewell Records]

ISABEL TOWLE WITCHCRAFT TRIAL

In July, 1680, a little child of John Godfrey died, and the old cry of witchcraft was raised. An inquest was held, with twelve solid men of Hampton for jurers, and a verdict rendered: "We find grounds for suspicion that the said child was murdered by witchcraft." Rachel Fuller was blamed.

ISABEL TOWLE - WITCHCRAFT TRIAL Cont.

Goody (Isabel) Towle was arraigned about the same time, on a different charge, and both she and Rachel Fuller were committed to prison till the setting of the Hampton Court, Sept. 7, 1680. Then "The Court having heard ye case of Rachel Fuller and Isabel Towle being apprehended and committed upon suspition of witchcraft doe order yt they still containe in prisson till bond be given for their good behaviour of £100 a piece during the Courts pleasure.

John Fuller became bondsman for his wife, and Isaac Marston and John Redman, for Goody Towle. They were discharged at the Dover Court the next year.

COMMENTS:

Since her husband Philip Towle was living why didn't he post her bond? From his probate records we learn that he wasn't poor. Neither Marston or Redman, who posted the bond, were related to Isabel Towle. So why did they do it? Quite a puzzle.

AUTHORS BIOGRAPHY

WILLIAM HASLET JONES, has done extemsive English genealogical research in original records at the Public Record Office, London, England and at the County Record Offices of; Cumberland, Devon, Essex, Northamptonshire, Hertfordshire, Lancastershire, Norfolk, Shropshire, Warwickshire and Westmoreland, with additional studies conducted at various English libraries including: Society of Genealogists and St. Catherine's House in London, at the West County Studies library, Exeter, at the Norwich City library, etc.

The results from his English research have been published in the NEHGR REGISTER, and included in two books; John B. Threlfall's ENGLISH ORIGINS OF 50 EARLY NEW ENGLAND FOUNDERS, (1990), and in HISTORY OF THE TOWN OF HAMPTON, N.H. (1989), in connection with their 350th anniversary.

Mr. Jones has conducted North American research at the National Archives and at the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C.; at the State Archives of: Arkansas, Illinois, Kansas, Maine, Missouri, New Hampshire, Tennessee Wisconsin: at State Historical Society Libraries in these States; and at various public and private libraies including the D.A.R. library, Washington, D.C., the Newberry Library, Chicago, Ill., The Southern Baptist Library, Nashville, Tenn., The NEHGS Library, Boston, Mass., the Allen County Library, Ft. Wayne, Ind., the Chattanooga Public library, McGhee-Lawson Library, Knoxville, Tenn. and the Family History Ceneter library. Additional research was conducted at more than 40 County Court Houses in the above named states.

Mr. Jones has served for many years as a volunteer librarian at the Naperville, Illinois branch library of the Family History Center of the Church of Jesus Christ of Later Day Saints.

FINAL THOUGHTS

The English records do not prove with any certainty that Philip Towle of Hampton, N.H. came from the parish of Crediton in County Devon, England. Circumstantial evidence does support this theory. There was a young man named Philip Towle last named in 1641 at Crediton. No marriage or death entry was found in the parish register for Crediton or for any of the adjacent parishes. He certainly could have emigrated to New England. Perhaps he took care of his stepmother and wasn't free to leave until after her death in 1649.

A review of all TOWLE names found in England, for the time period prior to 1700, as found in the Morman International Genealogical Index for 1993, showed that 82 % resided in County Devon. The name of Philip Towle only appeared in Devon and primarily in the Crediton area some 26 times. Logic says that this is where Philip Towle of Hampton probably came from. Regretfully the 1631 will of Philip Towle of Crediton was lost during World War 2. It would have helped to resolve the question.

The question remains; why did Philip Towle come to New England and to Hampton, N.H. in particular? If Roger Towle of early Boston, Mass. was a brother or close relative, that could explain why he came to New England. Can we find any connection between Crediton and New England? Yes we can. Rev. William Cook was the vicar at Crediton from 1595 till his death in 1615. [Most likely he married Philip Towell and Margaret Whyte in 1610] Rev. Cook married in 1597 Martha Whyte the daughter of John Whyte of Standon St. John in Oxford. Was there a possible family connection between the Whytes of Crediton and Oxford? I found none, but we can't rule it out. Rev. Cook had a daughter Elizabeth born about 1602 at Crediton. She married in 1627 William Walton. They later emigrated to Marblehead, Mass. Thus there a is possible

connection between Crediton and New England. [See NEHGR v.188, p. 361-8]

On the negative side we do not find any commonality between the given names used at Hampton and those used at Crediton. Only 25 % agreement was found. But we note that all the names used by Philip Towle of Hampton were biblical names! This may explain the differences.

We don't know the occupation of Philip Towle named in 1641 at Crediton. His father was a carpenter, so most likely he followed the same trade. From Hampton, N.H. records it appears that Philip Towle was a farmer, but he may have also been a carpenter.

PHILIP TOWLE, HAMPTON, N.H.

INTRODUCTION

Among the early settlers of Hampton, N.H. was a Philip Towle. He married ISABELLA AUSTIN there in 1657. The Philip Towle family history in New England was presented by Mrs. A. Lindsey in the NEHGR in 1889, v.43, pg 364. The GENEALOGICAL DICTIONARY OF MAINE & NEW HAMPSHIRE, by Sybil Noyes, etal, Portland, Me. 1928-1939 covers the Towle family of Hampton. Other sources information on the New England Towles include Joseph Dow, HISTORY OF THE TOWN OF HAMPTON. N.H., Salem, Mass. 1893 and Langdon B. Parson, HISTORY OF THE TOWN OF RYE, N.H., Concord, N.H. 1905. At the Newberry Library, Chicago, Illinois large manuscript collection there is а accumulated by Simon Towle of Detroit, Mich. dated 1877 on the Towles of North America. None of these sources identifies the birthplace of Philip Towle.

A search was conducted by the author for the home of Philip Towle. The name of Towle was found to definitely be English in origin. Joseph Dow's contention that he was of Irish ancestry can not be supported. The name was very common in the 16th and 17th centuries, especially in County Devonshire along the River Exe. The name was generally spelled TOWELL, but TOWLE was a common variant. The name was found in other counties such as London, Northampton, Norfolk and elsewhere, but to a much lessor extent.

Research was conducted by the author at the Devon Record Office, Castle, Exeter, England; at the West Country Studies Library, Exeter, England; at the Royal Genealogical Society Library, London; at the Public Record Office, London; at the Newberry Library, Chicago, Illinois and elsewhere including the Morman Family History Center. Regretfully Devon parish registers are incomplete and all probate records for Devon were lost in WW2. Even so, based upon surviving records for Devon it seems more than

likely that Philip Towle came from the parish of Crediton, County Devon, England.

For the time period from 1577 through 1650, the name of PHILIP TOWELL/TOWLE appears some 16 times in English records. All of these entries occurred in Co. Devon. And with two exceptions, all of these men named Philip Towle lived in or near the parish of Crediton. It therefore seems quite likely that this was the home of Philip Towle of Hampton, N.H.

One individual named Philip Towle was found of the correct age living at Crediton in Co. Devonshire. Perhaps he was the immigrant, since he is not named in later records. This Philip was named in the 1641 Protection Record for Devonshire at Crediton. He was born about 1616 the son of PHILIP TOWELL and his wife MARGARET WHYTE. He can't be ruled out as the Philip Towle of Hampton, N.H.

The earliest PHILIP TOWLE found in England resided at the parish of Lapford, Co. Devonshire. He married there on 19 Oct. 1577 FLORANCE DOW of the parish of Winckleigh. Philip may have been a brother of ROGER TOWLE of nearby Colebrooke parish. Roger Towle was the great grandfather of Philip Towle of Crediton.

From existing parish and other public records, the author has constructed the following pedigree. It offers one possible solution using all of the available information. Hopefully additional research in the future will confirm this solution.
